German Ambassador His Excellency Dr. Christophe Eick Discusses Bilateral Cooperation with Minister of Foreign Affairs the Rt. Hon. Dr. Denzil Douglas

Basseterre, **Saint Kitts (5**th **June 2024)** – His Excellency Dr. Christophe Eick, the newly appointed Ambassador of the Federal Republic of Germany to Saint Kitts and Nevis, paid a courtesy call on the Honourable Dr. Denzil Douglas, Minister of Foreign Affairs of Saint Kitts and Nevis, to strengthen bilateral ties and explore avenues of collaboration between the two nations.
