In addition, the Ministry wishes to advise that the Language Training Program is **optional**, and students need to provide documentation that they have either applied to a Mandarin Program or an English taught Degree Program.

Eligibility Requirements:

Applicants must submit the following documents for consideration:

- A completed application form (attached for convenience)
- A photocopy of a valid passport
- A certified copy of the highest diploma earned and academic transcripts (certified by the Ministry of Education)
- Proof of application to an educational institution or its affiliated Mandarin Training Center
- Two letters of reference
